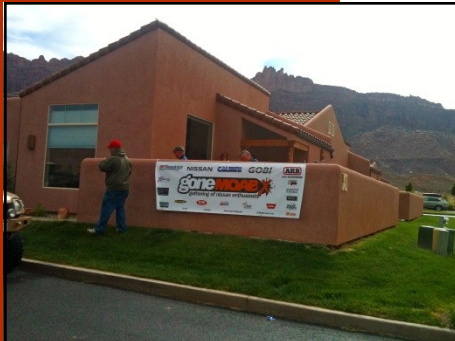

Maintenance

I can not stress this enough..... Start looking at your truck NOW!!!!

Start with your cooling system... running in the desert at slow speeds in high temps can really stress a system. I would then recommend to start checking from the tires back.

- Tires
- Hubs
- Brakes
- Steering
- Differentials
- Drivelines
- T-case
- Suspension

Check for anything loose, leaks, worn and then begin working to replace them now.

The slick rock in the area has a tendency to find the weak spots in a truck. So take some time starting now so you have the best chance to enjoy your week in Moab with out incidence.

CBs??? Yes, you do need one.

Do you have a CB?? Well you better, it is required for the event.

We tried running FRS radios but they just do not work well, any hill or distance in the group and the truck metal will interfere on both ends.

A CB will not have these issues since most of them have an

external antenna, better electronics and when properly tuned a CB will always work better than any FRS.

Ideal setup:

- CB with a box.. The compact handheld units don't seem to work quite as well plus the box units are cheaper.
- External Antenna... pick up a tunable antenna.

Find a buddy with a SWR meter or if you look around there are companies that can help you set the SWR so you get the best performance.



External antennas work far better than internal. Also window mounted do not work great especially on tinted windows.
